Feedback on Management Issues

1. Major shift in responsibilities – contractor & administrator
2. Requires opportunity to transfer & learn new requirements
3. Training obligations – contract administration & asphalt laboratory skills
4. Equipment, test methods, mix designs & capable staff
5. Warranty implies performance is possible – within limits
6. 12 month surface deformation limitation – selection & loads
7. Demonstration projects – required, limits during implementation
8. Demo project – costs different (seals/binder/lime), auditing required
9. Project warranty assessments – 12 months / 24 months – process & \$
10. Timeline / Time table to delivery
11. Opportunities for demonstration projects – TMR / LG
12. Feedback and specification & system upgrades
